with mountains as part of the landscape.



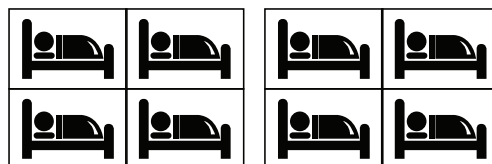
Birthplace of the Margarita and the

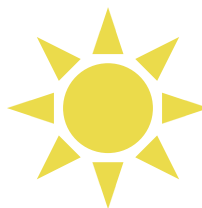
