Dear Commissioner Morath:

During the last SBOE meeting on January 28, 2022, my colleagues raised concerns about a charter school application submitted by Sunny Glen Children's Home in San Benito, Texas. I am highly disturbed by some of the publicly available information concerning this applicant.

Sunny Glen operates group foster homes in my district. A review of Texas Department of Family and Protective Services records by Type Investigations<sup>1</sup> in 2020 documented 140 deficiencies attributed to Sunny Glen since 2016. Some of those deficiencies involved corporal punishment, and in one case, violating a state standard against "restraints that obstruct a child's airway."

Sunny Glen contracted with the federal Office of Refugee Resettlement and SOG International in 2019 to house unaccompanied migrant children inside a former Wal-Mart in Raymondville under the name "New Day Resiliency Center." A report from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services obtained by Judicial Watch<sup>2</sup> documented five cases of sexual abuse at Sunny Glen New Day Resiliency Center over the course of a one-month period in 2021.

The troubled history of Sunny Glen's foster homes is disturbing enough. But it is beyond outrageous that anyone involved with running a child prison camp would think they are qualified to run a school.

Our precious children deserve better. I urge your office to thoroughly investigate this applicant and ensure they do not receive one more dime of our taxpayer dollars.
