

TEST NAME	Description	Grade Levels
ACPs	Assessments of Course Performance (ACPs) are semester exams in grades 3 through 12. Subject areas vary by grade level.	3 - 12
Circle	CIRCLE determines growth and development of your 3- or 4-year-old. The teacher asks the student to respond to various pictures, symbols, objects and words related to Language, Literacy, Math, and Social Emotional Learning.	PK
Common Assessments	Common Assessments are a mid-semester check on student learning. These assessments specifically test what has been taught in the curriculum. These tests are given online and are for STAAR Grades and subjects.	3 - 12
MAP (Read/Math K - 8 and Science 5)	MAP is an adaptive computer assessment that measures what a student knows in reading, math, or science based on grade level norms. MAP can determine academic growth over time, allowing teachers to track a student's progress throughout the school year and across multiple years. This supports teachers in determining who needs additional support or enrichment to meet or exceed grade level expectations.	K - 8
MAP Reading Fluency	MAP Reading Fluency is an adaptive computer assessment to monitor oral reading fluency, reading comprehension, and foundational reading skills. It quickly screens students for risk of reading difficulty, including characteristics of dyslexia.	K - 2
PSAT	The PSAT is a baseline for college readiness, testing skills in reading, writing, and math.	8, 10
Running Records	Determines a student's reading level. The teacher listens to a student read several books, makes notes about their reading skills, and asks the student to think and talk about each book.	K - 2
SAT	The SAT is an entrance exam used by colleges and universities to make admissions decisions. The purpose of the SAT is to measure student's readiness for college by assessing Math and	9-12
STAAR/End of Course (EOC)	STAAR/EOCs are the state mandated academic tests for Grades 3-12. Subject areas vary by grade level.	3- 12
TELPAS	The Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System measures the English language development and proficiency of students who are identified as Emergent Bilinguals in grades K-12.	K - 12
TSIA	The TSIA2 Assessment serves as a vital tool for students preparing for college by evaluating their academic skills and knowledge in areas such as reading, writing, and mathematics.	9-12
TX-KEA	TX-KEA determines your child's readiness for and in Kindergarten. The teacher asks the student to respond to various pictures, symbols, objects and words related to Language, Literacy, Math, and Social Emotional Learning.	K
