Submit comments on bills to Texas House committees – all online.

Why?

Your comments give legislators hard proof of where Texans stand on issues.

Public comments allow you to have a voice on legislation that affects you and your students without having to take off work to go to the Capitol.

These comments stay on the public record – no one can hide what Texans really think.

How?

Bills are posted to the website above at least 72 hours before they're heard in a House committee.

You can submit comments as soon as a bill is posted on the portal all the way through the end of the committee hearing.
